Which horse in 2018 is the most recent to achieve the US Triple Crown

Justify

Donnacha O'BRIEN as a jockey won the 2000 Guineas in consecutive years in 2018 and 2019. Name EITHER of the TWO winning horses

Saxon Warrior, Grecia Magna

Which THREE horses have been trained by Willie MULLINS to win the Grand National

Hedgehunter; I am Maximus; Nick Rockett

The owner of Gainsay, winner of the Ritz Club Trophy at Cheltenham in 1987, was the lead singer of a group which had 38 UK chart singles, many of which he had written or co-written, he received an MBE and an Ivor Novello Award. Name him OR his group.

Errol BROWN; Hot Chocolate

Which Cheltenham Gold Cup winner and Grand National runner-up in the same year is named after a racecourse in Bridgetown, Barbados

Garrison Savannah

Name ONE of the THREE horses to win the Triple Crown of Hurdling - The Fighting Fifth Hurdle, The Christmas Hurdle and the Champion Hurdle in the same season

Kribensis; Buveur d'Air; Constitution Hill

Boxing

Name THREE of the FOUR boxers who immediately succeeded Marvin HAGLER as WBC Middleweight Champion. None successfully defended the title for a variety of reasons

Sugar Ray LEONARD; Thomas HEARNS; Iran BARKLEY; Roberto DURAN

Name THREE of the FOUR men to defeat George FOREMAN other than Muhammad ALI.

Jimmy YOUNG; Evander HOLYFIELD; Tommy MORRISON; Shannon BRIGGS

Between his victory over Joe FRAZIER in January 1973 and his defeat by ALI in October 1974 George FOREMAN only fought TWICE. Name EITHER of his opponents

Jose ROMAN; Ken NORTON

Whose first professional defeat was in his 91st professional fight to Frankie RANDALL, his second came in his 99th fight to Oscar de la HOYA. He had 107 wins, 6 defeats and 2 draws and won the WBC Super-Featherweight, WBA & WBC Lightweight and WBC & IBF Light Welterweight titles

Julio Caesar CHAVEZ

Which former WBC Super-Featherweight, WBC Lightweight and WBO Light-Welterweight champion between 1983 and 1992 was shot and subsequently died in his native Puerto Rico in 2012

Hector CAMACHO

Against whom did Evander HOLYFIELD contest a win, a loss and a draw in 2000 and 2001, all for the WBA World Heavyweight title.

John RUIZ

Which Olympic Gold Medallist is now the Mayor for Hull & East Yorkshire representing Reform UK

Luke CAMPBELL

Who in September 2025 retained the undisputed World Super-Bantamweight title, taking his professional record to 31 wins and no defeats.

Naoya INOUE

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Rugby

Alex MURPHY coached which TWO teams as a player-coach to Challenge Cup final victories

Leigh - 1971; Warrington - 1974

Which TWO teams have appeared and won on their only Rugby League Challenge Cup Final appearances

Rochdale Hornets (1922); Sheffield Eagles (1998)

Who played for Wigan throughout his career winning the Championship / Super League three times, the Premiership three times, the Regal Trophy, Challenge Cup, Harry Sunderland trophy and Lance Todd trophy once. He was awarded an OBE and is currently CEO of Wigan

Kris RADLINSKI

Castleford Tigers have had FIVE Man of Steel winners since 1999. Name ONE

Adrian VOWLES; Rangi CHASE; Daryl CLARK; Luke GAYLE; Paul McSHANE

Which TWO teams were involved in the 2009 Heineken Cup Quarter Final which will be remembered for the Bloodgate scandal?

Harlequins; Leinster

Which Country finished THIRD in the 1987 World Cup AND which country finished THIRD in the 2007 World Cup

Wales; Argentina

Who captained England from 2012-2015. He was appointed captain despite only achieving one cap previously?

Chris ROBSHAW

Which team won the Courage League Division 1 title in seasons 1989-90 and 1996-97 and the Zurich Premiership in 2002-03, 2003-04 and 2004-05 and the Guinness Premiership in 2007-08. All four Premiership titles were achieved via the play-offs having finished second in the League.

Which TWO skiers were at various times declared winner of the Grenoble 1968 Olympics Men's Slalom Gold. The issue came in the second run when one was disqualified. There were concrete suggestions that partisan officials attempted to unfairly manipulate the result.

Jean-Claude KILLY; Karl SCHRANZ

Which Ukrainian won Olympic Gold in 1994, the year of the Tonya HARDING / Nancy KERRIGAN incident AND name EITHER of the US Women skaters who won Olympic Gold in 1992 or 1998.

Oksana BAIUL; Kristi YAMAGUCHI; Tara LIPINSKI

Who until April 2025 held the record of most regular season goals in the history of the NHL AND which Washington Capitals star overtook him

Wayne GRETZKY; Alex OVECHKIN

Stein ERIKSEN won Giant Slalom Gold in 1952 but who was the next Norwegian to win an Olympic skiing Gold.

Kjetil-Andre AAMODT (1992)

Which Ski-Jumper won the Olympic Large Hill in 1984 AND both the Large & Normal Hill in 1988 along with the team Gold AND Who won the Olympic Normal and Large Hill in both 2002 and 2010

Matti NYKANEN; Simon AMMANN

Which country won Olympic bronzes in 1994, 1998, 2010 and 2014, Olympic silvers in 1988 and 2006, finally winning Olympic Gold in 2022.

Flojo has held the Women's 100m World Record since 1988. Between 1977 and 1988 TWO women broke or equalled the record on FIVE occasions. Name them.

Marlies OELSNER-GOHR; Evelyn ASHFORD

Name TWO of the THREE women who have between them the top ELEVEN performances in the Long Jump, the most recent being in 1992.

Galina CHISTYAKOVA (WR-1988) (3); Jackie JOYNER-KERSEE (3); Heike DRECHSLER (5)

Christos PAPANIKOLAOU in 1970 became the first individual to pole vault 18 feet. Who broke this record TWO years later, setting THREE World Records in under THREE months. He failed to win an Olympic medal but won two European Silvers. He did however win TWO European Superstars and was runner up in the first World Superstars.

Hideki MATSUYAMA; Cameron SMITH

In the US Opens of 1990, 1991, 1994, 2001 and 2008. The winner won following a sudden death play-off. Name THREE of the FIVE Winners

1990 - Hale IRWIN; 1991 - Payne STEWART; 1994 - Ernie ELS; 2001 - Retief GOOSEN; 2008 - Tiger WOODS

Royal Birkdale

Cricket

Name the TWO England batsmen, one who scored 136 first class centuries and retired in 2008, the OTHER scored 114 first class centuries and retired in 2012

Graeme HICK; Mark RAMPRAKASH

Who is the only man who has scored 2000 or more test runs at TWO different grounds

Mahela JAYAWARDENE (Colombo and Galle)

Who played for the RAF and one match for Hampshire 2nd XI. From June 2nd 1966 he was employed by the BBC covering 377 tests including all 246 held in England. He died in January 2009 of Legionnaire's disease.

Bill FRINDALL

Name the THREE cricketers to win BBC Overseas SPotY, doing so in 1966, 1994 and 2005

Garfield SOBERS; Brian LARA; Shane WARNE

Whose England international career consisted of three tests and three ODIs from 1984 - 1985 scoring ten runs and taking four wickets. He played for one county throughout his career taking 666 wickets including 100 in 1987. He was a Wisden cricketer of the year in 1988.

Jonathan AGNEW

Who scored a Somerset record innings of 371 against Worcestershire in 2025 AND who scored a Worcestershire record innings of 405 against Somerset in 1988, both being at Taunton

Tom BANTON; Graeme HICK

Which Indian batsman scored 264 in a one-day international against Sri Lanka, the first time anyone has passed 250 in an ODI?

Rohit Sharma

Who took innings stats of 9 - 28 v Sussex in 1964, 9 - 37 v Essex in 1966 and 9 - 32 v Surrey in 1968.
